



NOTICE OF A NEW WATER USE LICENCE PROCESS FOR THE INCREASE OF THE WATER ALLOCATION FROM THE BRANDVLEI DAM FOR THE LANGEBERG MUNICIPALITY

Notice is hereby given in that a Water Use Licence Application (WULA) in terms of the National Water Act, 1998 (act No. 36 of 1998) will be lodged with the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS), that the Langeberg Municipality (LLM) proposes the Increase of The Water Allocation from the Brandvlei Dam for The Langeberg Municipality.

An New Water Use Licence Application will be submitted to the Breede-Gouritz Catchment Management Agency (BGCMA) as required by the National Water Act (Act 36 of 1998). This process will be conducted to ensure that the environmental impacts that may be associated with the proposed project are taken into consideration. Interested and Affected parties (I&APs) have an opportunity to comment by providing issues of concern and/or suggestions for enhanced benefits and/or alternatives; and to ensure that the competent authority, the BGCMA, has sufficient information to make a decision.
