



INVITATION FOR TENDERS

Tenders are hereby invited from accredited suitably qualified service providers for the **UPGRADING OF ASHTON MATERIAL RECOVERY FACILITY**.

Completed tenders in sealed envelopes clearly marked “**T56/2019: UPGRADING OF ASHTON MATERIAL RECOVERY FACILITY**” must be placed in the tender box, at the Municipal Offices, 28 Main Road, Ashton not later than 12:00 on

20 MARCH 2020.

The official tender document must be fully completed in black ink and must not be dismantled

Late tenders or tenders received by fax/email or incomplete tenders will not be accepted. The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. Proof of dispatch of a tender will not be regarded as proof of receipt thereof. Tenders will be evaluated according to the Council's Supply Chain Management Policy and the 80/20-point system will apply. The Supply Chain Management Policy can be viewed during normal office hours at the Municipal Offices.

Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB in a CE class of construction works and have a grading designation equal to or higher than that determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with regulation 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, 2004. It is estimated that tenderers will need a grading designation of 1CE or higher.

Only goods, works and services with the minimum threshold as applicable to local production and content will be considered.

A compulsory clarification meeting will be held on **02 MARCH 2020** at 10:00 – Langeberg Municipality offices, 28 Main Road Ashton
